The following awards are presented for accomplishment in various categories as described below. The recipients of trophies will retain them for one year.

3M Award Trophy

• Awarded to the member with the winning entry from the Image-of-the-Year Competition.

Photographer-of-the-Year Trophy

- Awarded to the member(s) earning the highest aggregate points, per division.
- For purposes of the Photographer of the Year Trophies, aggregate points will be the total points earned, less the members' lowest category score, the same as calculated when advancing between divisions.
- Intermediate Division winner will receive the McDonald Trophy
- Advanced Division winner will receive the President's Trophy
- Superset Division winner will receive the Ian Billington Trophy

Bob Campbell Memorial Award

• Awarded to the member(s) earning the highest scoring Nature image (any division).

Foster Trophy by Carling O'Keefe

• Awarded to the member(s) with the highest scoring Canadian Landscape image in the Landscape competition (any division), in years where a Landscape competition is held.

Don Dawson Memorial Award for Photographic Excellence

Awarded to the member(s) with the highest scoring Print.

Art & Rita Tracey Memorial Audio Visual Award

• Awarded to the member(s) with the highest scoring Audio Visual presentation.

Don Dawson joined ECC in 2001, a member for about 9 years, serving on the Board for Seven. He assisted with Image Evaluation, Salons, ribbons, and annual awards. Don came from the Toronto Camera Club, and with his experience and skill became a Superset member with much talent. He loved photography and enjoyed getting up early to photograph the magical light of dawn – his favourite time. His special interest was nature and scenics, his images all conveyed a wonderful mood, were beautifully composed and captured.

A dedicated photographer, Don was always ready to share his knowledge and expertise. Even as his health was failing, he enjoyed a ride to the Club to view images and shows, and chat with other members. Don passed away June 27th, 2011. His wife, Betty, and their family approached ECC about creating an award in Don's memory and Betty selected this image which was very special to Don. It scored a perfect score in competition; a scenic of Gold Hill in the village of Shaftesbury, England.


