Photo Enterprises.

Robert has been travelling with his cameras from the High Canadian and Greenlandic Arctic to Spain, from Iceland to Central Europe, Russia and Malta, and many places in between, sharing his impressions and experiences through slide shows and lectures.

Robert is a resident lecturer for the ROMLife Programmes, and also teaches a variety of Photography classes at the Royal Ontario Museum, and other venues.

Robert has produced shows - no mere travelogues, but rich in local history, architecture and culture - on behalf of Tourist Boards, Camera Clubs, and Social Clubs. His work has appeared in Toronto Life Magazine, The Chicago Tribune, The Globe and Mail, The Toronto Star, and other publications.
